Coaching Accreditation



Overview

Education leaders with a strong interest in deepening their coaching expertise may seek accreditation as a Coaching Fellow or Advanced Coaching Fellow. BTS Spark is a global educational leadership coaching organisation, and our accreditation process offers a rigorous development pathway to develop your coaching capability, with support from a coach trainer.

Coaching Fellows

- Start by selecting four modules from our Coaching Capability Curriculum (see diagram).
- Undertake these modules through oneto-one coaching, group coaching or workshops.
- Then apply for Coaching Fellowship accreditation. This involves recording a 20-30 minute coaching conversation, and then undergoing a 60 minute supervision session with a BTS coach trainer to get feedback on your coaching. This offers an invaluable opportunity to strengthen your coaching with professional guidance.

Advanced Coaching Fellows

Advanced Coaching Fellowship recognises your versatility coaching different needs. Complete eight coaching modules from BTS' Coaching Capability Curriculum, through oneto-one coaching, group coaching or workshops.

Then apply for Advanced Coaching Fellowship accreditation. This involves three sessions with a BTS coach trainer to demonstrate your expertise in Development Conversations, Feedback Conversations and flexing your coaching to match the needs of your coachee.
